1. **Project 'ECHS Sparsh Seva aur Samman'**. Service personnel are provided medical cover through Military Hospitals during their active service period. ECHS has been operationalized from 01 Apr 2003 with the aim to provide quality medical care to the ESM and their dependents post their retirement. To further maximize the benefits of the scheme, **PROJECT SPARSH** was launched on **10 Oct 2017 by President AWWA** by forging an association to extend sharing and caring to our veterans and their dependents undergoing treatment in ECHS Polyclinics through a volunteer-based program. The project intends to mobilize ECHS volunteers by integrating veteran communities in the activities of ECHS and involving NCC / NSS / NGOs to connect and help the elderly beneficiaries. In the long term, Project 'Sparsh Seva aur Samman' will assist in the effective functioning of polyclinics incl grievance redressal, counselling and other such requirements to help the ECHS beneficiaries.

1. Lec on Garbh Sanskar by Dr Pushpa Pandey. A symposium on 'Garbh Sanskar' (phase-I) for the ladies of Armed Forces fraternity was conducted at Batra Auditorium, Jabalpur Mil Stn on 14 Dec 2024 under the aegis of HQ MB Area and Zonal AWWA. The event was conducted by Dr Pushpa Pandey and her team of Obstetricians and Gynecologists from Jabalpur and Delhi. The session highlighted the importance of holistic prenatal care, combining traditional Indian practices with modern science to promote the well-being of both mother and child. Dr Pushpa Pandey emphasized the role of a positive mindset, balanced nutrition, yoga, and meditation during pregnancy. The practical demonstrations and scientific insights were well-received by the audience. Attendees appreciated the interactive format and found the session inspiring and informative, gaining valuable guidance on integrating "Garbh Sanskar" practices into their lives. The audience was sensitized about the importance of holistic development of women, which significantly improves outcomes of pregnancy and the newborn. Total of 400 ladies attended the event. A total of 424 attended the same.

2. After Phase I, Phase II is also planned in Mar 2025. The programme is intended to be conducted in the following manner: -

(a) <u>Phase-II</u>. Phase I was completed on 14 Dec 2024. In Phase 2, a 45 minute programme for all pregnant ladies and ladies desirous of conceiving, at MH Jabalpur on a monthly basis is planned. Around 40-50 such ladies available in the station coordinated by the Dept of Obs & Gyn MH Jabalpur will take part in these sessions and it is desirable that each lady attends at least 3-5 of these monthly sessions to gain maximum benefit. These sessions will include dietary advice and a session on exercises for physical wellbeing. These sessions will include dietary advice and a session on exercises for physical wellbeing. The first session of phase-II will be held in the month of Feb 2025 after obtaining consent from participants & ethical clearance from the ethical committee at Jabalpur medical college. Husbands of the pregnant ladies present in the stn will also take part in these sessions.

(b) <u>Phase-III</u>. This phase is aimed at elderly ladies – the caregivers at the homes of pregnant ladies. The sessions will focus on sensitizing elderly about their role in the physical, mental and spiritual well-being of the pregnant ladies under their care.

3. The programme will be conducted on a purely voluntary / honorary basis by Dr Pushpa Pandey and her team of experts and only logistic support for conduct of the sessions will be required to be provided by MB Area. Maj Vijaya Swarnim, MO (Mircobiology) from MH Jabalpur is the nodal offr for this programme, to coordinate all present and future events. Dr Pushpa Pandey and her team are eager to train volunteers from the stn to carry forward the sessions on a regular basis. A group of volunteers (Medical Offrs, Nursing Offrs, Para medical & Non medical ladies) can be identified to be trained. After successful implementation of the 'Garbh Sanskar' programme as part of the Shiv Shakti Project at Jabalpur, it can be rolled out in other stns of MB Area in the next phase and extended to the rest of the country, if found to be beneficial.







4. <u>Session on "Role of Mediation in Conflict Resolution in Matrimonial Disputes"</u>. 


