Visit to Sanjhi Chatt (Veemais and Girls Hostel) Jaipur by Regional President AWWA, South Western Command

She also informed them about educational opportunities available for them in Rashtriya Indian College, Srisri Sobab, Military Schools and Nizorayas Vidhyalayas.

She also assured them that Indian Army is committed and dedicated in the genuine & welfare of their wards and their ward.



INTRACTION –VEER NARIS & WIDOWS

- utmost importance is being given to look after the veer Naris/widows of Command. Periodic visits / interaction are carried out by the unit Satat Milap Teams and through outreach campaign to look after them and to address their issues. veer Naris / widows willing to work have been employed in the entities, with the aim to empower them.
- A cell has been established in each regiment / unit under One JCO and Two NCOs to monitor the well-being of veer Naris as well as ex-servicemen and widows. The Satat Milap Team is in regular contact with the veer Naris and the widows. The veer Naris are contacted twice in a week while the widows are contacted once in two weeks telephonically. The veer Naris and widows have been given the numbers of the Satat Milap Team including the Officer in-charge and JCOs mobile numbers and have been assured assistance if and when required. Interaction with all veer Naris/widows was carried out to confirm their well-being and they were rendered advice and help with respect to COVID.
